- To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **B. M. Education Foundation Trust, Shekhawati Ayurvedic College Behal Road, Harikunj, Ganga Colony, Teh. Chirawa, Dist. Jhunjhunu, Pilani-333031, Rajasthan (Inst. ID.- AYU0231)** inspection was conducted on **15.04.2025 and 16.04.2025 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**
- The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder. **On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-**

1. Teaching Staff :-

- Availability of total teaching staff for UG(BAMS) Course as per the part-1 submitted by the college is



2. Mean of general and essential equipment's/instruments availability is 96.97%.

 - iv) The shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 2 above, shall be fulfilled.
- 13) In case if you are not satisfied with the decision of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM, you may prefer an appeal addressed to the Chairman NCISM, within 15 days of issuance of the letter as per Regulation 65 of MESAR 2024 and Regulation 29(5) of NCISM Act 2020.
- 14) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
