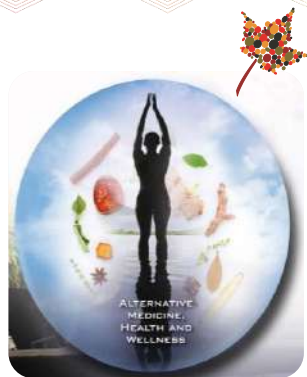


Dear friend's,
